














Step 1. Sign In

Step 2. Install apps	
<p>a. Select the Windows icon at the bottom screen, and then open the Company Portal application. If requested, sign in with your school user name and password.</p>	
<p>b. Select Show all to see the apps your school has indicated you require.</p>	
<p>c. Select an app to install. In this example, we will use BYOx Mapper</p>	

<p>d. Select the Install button.</p>	
<p>e. A downloading message will be displayed during installation.</p>	
<p>f. The app has finished installing.</p>	
<p>g. To check your app has installed, select Installed apps and see it in the list. Click the back arrow Company Portal to install additional apps, repeating steps b to g.</p>
