

Queensland Hydro Scholarships



Queensland Hydro is a publicly owned entity recently established by the Queensland Government to design, deliver, operate and maintain long duration pumped hydro energy storage assets that will be the cornerstone for transforming the state's energy system.

Queensland Hydro is currently investigating Borumba Dam, near Imbil, as a pumped hydro energy storage facility. A large and highly skilled team will be required to deliver the significant infrastructure project if the Borumba Pumped Hydro Project is approved.

Queensland Hydro is committed to supporting the development of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) skills in the Mary Valley and Gympie region.

Queensland Hydro is partnering with James Nash and Gympie State High School to deliver STEM focused scholarships for Year 11 and 12 students in 2023, 2024 and 2025.

In 2023, the Queensland Hydro STEM scholarships will support up to 40 students studying STEM subjects, across both schools.
