

3. PARENT CONTACT – please update contact details

ATTENDANCE – Mobile Phone Contact / QParents

Gympie State High School's attendance target for all students is 90%. Our attendance system notifies parents of unexplained absences via text messages. It is important that our records are up to date so parents can be contacted in a timely fashion if their child is absent from school.

EXPLAINING ABSENCES – Contact on the day of Absence

Each report issued provides information on student absences including those that are unexplained. It is important that all absences are explained in a timely fashion by note, QPARENTS, or by calling the school absence line on 5489 8333 and choose option 2.

REPORTING

Reports are emailed to parents at the end of each term. It is therefore important that your email address is accurate. Should you not have an email address, please ensure the school has your correct mailing address.

CENTREPAY – Deductions from your Centrelink Payments. This option can only be used **for school fees only**. Forms available from the main office. To take up one of these options, please contact the school Finance Officer on 5489 8302.

6. School Photos

School photos are on Week 3 – Friday 14th February and catch up day will be Week 4 – Thursday 20th February. Expectations for uniforms: Seniors (year 12) formal uniform, Seniors (years 10 & 11) and Juniors (years 7-9) will be in day uniform.

Please note: More information on how to order will be sent out closer to the date. Once you have placed an order for photos and on completion of photo days, these will automatically be sent to the school. We will advise when they are ready for collection.

If your child commences enrolment after the scheduled photo days, please ensure they present to the administration office to organise their photo to be taken for distribution of a Student ID card, and receive a Student Planner and Timetable on their first day.

When signing the publication/ media consent form on enrolment, please be aware if you do not consent to your child's photo being taken, they will NOT get a student ID card, school photos or be published in the yearbook. For your student to receive an ID card and published in the yearbook, FULL NAME consent for publications must be given.
