

BYOx Devices for 2017 - Book list addendum

Gympie State High School has implemented the Education Queensland Departmental BYOx solution, which enables students to bring a device to the school and be able to access network resources and the internet. From 2017, the school has added a BYOx device to the book list.



All students participating in the BYOx program will need to have all SRS fees and the Technology Fee of \$20 paid as well as returning a signed BYOx Charter Agreement, before they will be granted access.

Which exact device purchased and used is a parental choice, but the school recommends the following minimum specifications to ensure the device will provide a suitable learning experience for the student.

Additional information:

- For the Junior School, tablet devices such as iPads are acceptable as they are able to support word processing and internet connectivity, these being the most common uses for these year levels.
- It is recommended that you insure any BYOx device against accidental damage.
- Antivirus software must be installed on the device before it will be allowed to join the network.
- As per the BYOx charter, the school does not provide technical support beyond how to connect the device to the BYOx network.

Office 2016 for free!

All Queensland state school students can now download multiple free copies of Microsoft Office 2016 to their personal home computers and mobile BYOx devices. With Office 2016, students will have access to the latest version of Word for writing, Excel for spreadsheets, PowerPoint for presentations, and OneNote for organisation and notetaking.

Students use their school email address to sign in. The Office subscription lasts for as long as the student is studying at a Queensland state school. Support is available on downloading Office 2016.
