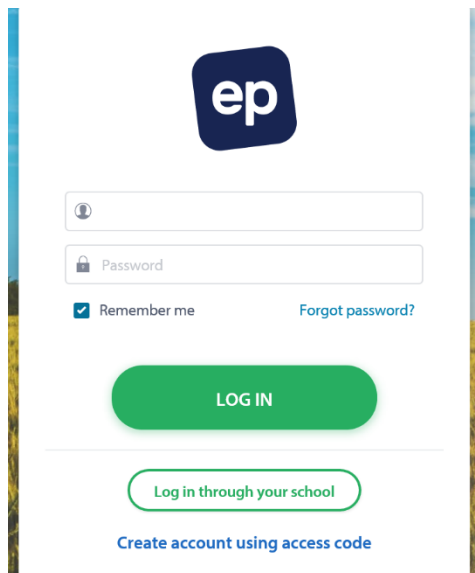
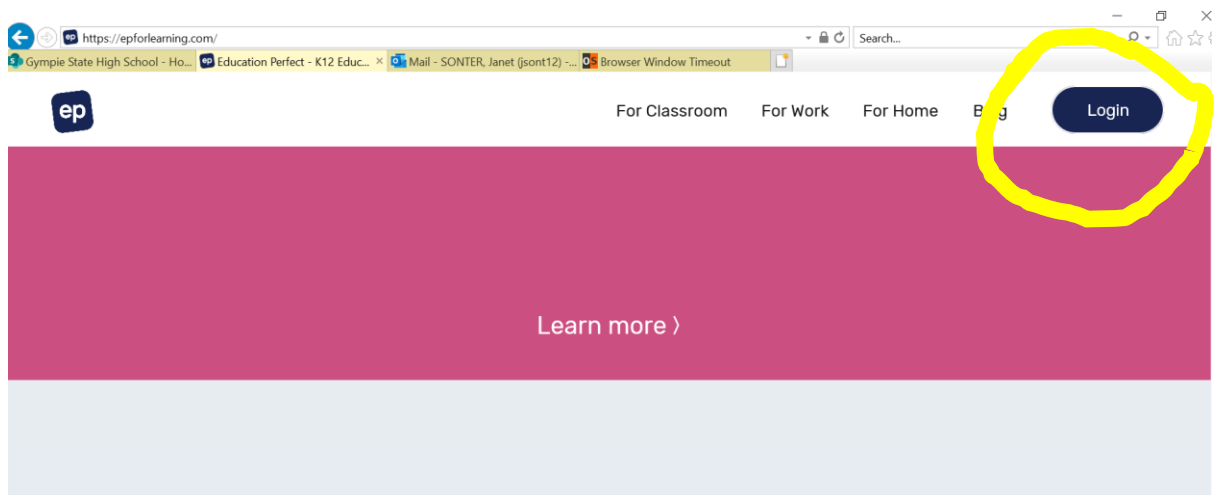

Type in education perfect into the search bar. Press on Login

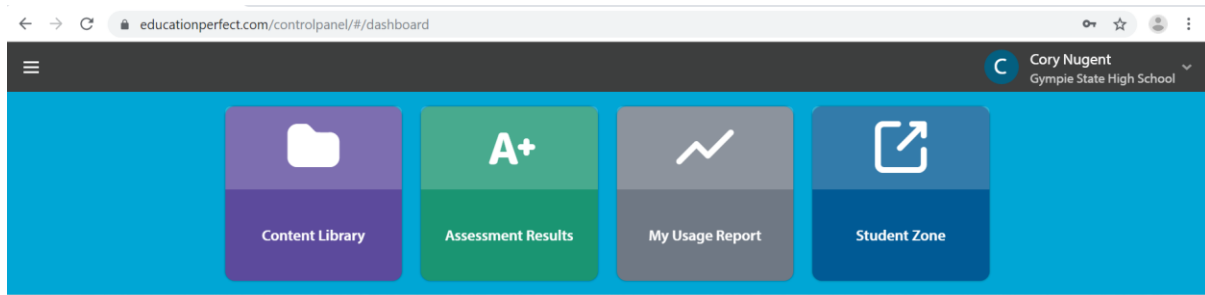

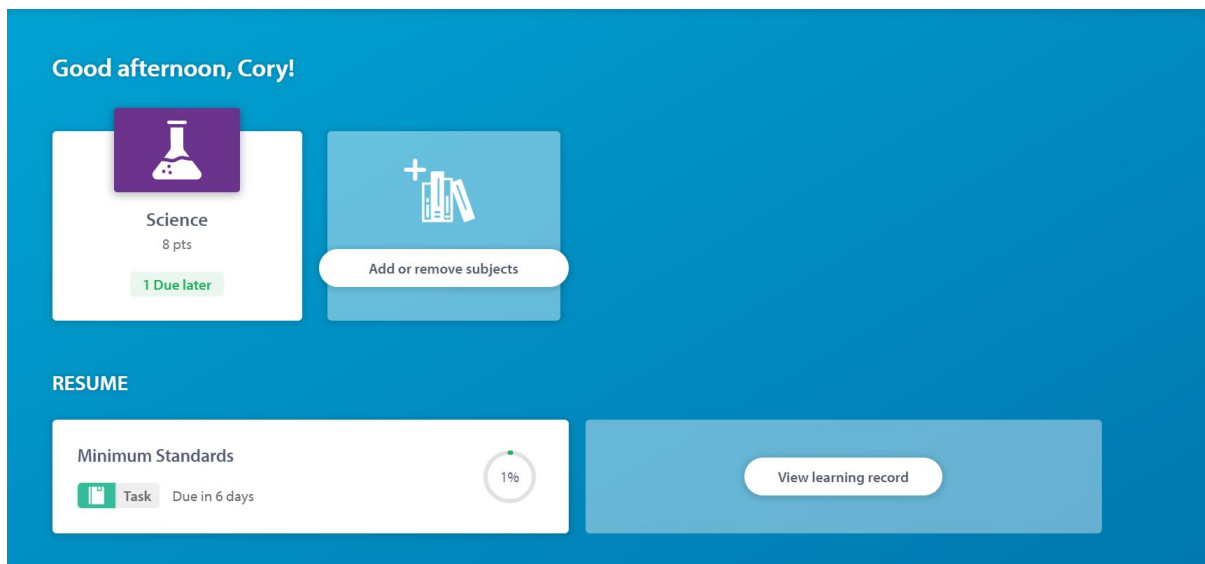


Step 4 – Scroll down to the individual lesson/task and click on the one you would like to open. Cory has already completed number 1, Accuracy. Thanks Cory!
