Scholarships are available to learners who have demonstrated a strong ethic towards achieving their personal best in their nominated area. Scholarships are awarded following an interview and a review of supporting documentation from the applicant's primary or p-10 school. Students may apply for more than one type of scholarship and are not required to sit an entry exam.

Scholarship recipients will be awarded uniform and fee bursaries as well as special entry into key programs.

- ask any questions about scholarships, the process and about Gympie State High School

All packages will be returned to applicants following a shortlisting process

All scholarship recipients will be reviewed annually and must maintain their levels of 90% or above of attendance, achievement and behaviour to retain their scholarship bursaries.

Successful scholarship recipients will be recognised at our Junior Awards Presentation Term 4, Thursday 17 October 2024, Lesson 3 starting at 1:00PM.

Aunty Olive Bennet, a respected elder of the Gubbi Gubbi Clan, has been instrumental in establishing indigenous services in the Gympie region. She has contributed significantly to raising the profile of Indigenous Education, Health and Employment. This Scholarship, in her name, recognises Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students who have demonstrated commitment to education by achieving in the areas of English and Mathematics, have exceptional behaviour and attendance, and demonstrated leadership capabilities in the school and wider community.

- one school uniform;
- individual case management and mentoring by our Indigenous Support Service team;
- a monetary contribution to the value of \$200.00 towards a range of Indigenous Support service partnership agencies and programs, such as Murri Pathways.

- one school uniform and one program shirt (CIA or GMSOE);
- arts enrichment programs;
- a monetary contribution to the value of \$200.00 towards an Arts enhancement program.
- Where relevant, activities as part of being a Screen and Media Gateway to Industry School.

Sporting Scholarship

Sporting Scholarships are offered to students entering Year 7 who demonstrate outstanding sporting achievements, integrity of character and are a proven role model via their conduct at school.
